

Restrictions Lifted beginning Sunday July 11th & going forwards:

Our provincial government has announced that, effective Sunday, July 11, all remaining Covid 19 restrictions are being lifted within Saskatchewan. In light of this announcement the Board of Elders met to determine how we should now proceed. The following contains outcomes from that meeting related to Prince of Peace:

Please note that:

1. As of Sunday (July 4) weekly registration for worship will no longer be required;
2. Mask wearing while in the church building will continue to be encouraged, but not required;
3. Gathering limits beyond 1/3 sanctuary capacity will be lifted;
4. Physical distancing, though not required, will continue to be encouraged where possible, along with other established safe Covid practices such as hand washing and sanitizing;
5. A few "in house" practices established during Covid such as receiving the offering upon entry or exit of the sanctuary, the pilgrim style method of Communion distribution and the exclusive use of individual glasses for Holy Communion, etc. will continue;
6. Worship services will continue to be live-streamed for those unable to attend worship in-person or who elect to delay their return until a later date.

We look forward to this return to normal, which will allow us to worship and share in God's Word all together once again.
